## Dancing News

### Society Website -

After a break from publishing books of new dances the Society has published a new book of dances, Book 46. But where do you find out details of how to obtain it. The new book has been available at Summer School, but supplies have apparently run out. Was it too popular? What can I say? It is not mentioned on the website shop either under Books or New Products. How do I buy It?

Special points of interest:

- *The two dances highlighted on page 4 are of particular interest and you should phone the organisers now to book your tickets*
- *Remember to send me your dance programmes ASAP Please!*
- *Contact details are on the back page as are some useful snippets of information*

If you want to purchase books or CD's from the shop that is no problem if you have something called a "Pay Pal" account. If you don't have such an account then you can't buy from the Society unless you visit their premises and hand over cash. Strangely there is no mention of this restricted payment option until you click through to actually buy something. I believe this type of account is popular with certain people, but why not also include Debit & Credit card payment?

There appear to be no terms or conditions for purchasing from the shop, nor customers statutory rights, nor a returns policy. I wonder how that affects the Society's position under the Distance Selling and other Regulations in force in this country? Local Trading Standards give free advice on selling on the web, *including which information must be legally provided to the purchaser prior to or during purchase!!* I sincerely hope this has been checked out by the Management Committee.

Looking for somewhere to dance tonight? Maybe you thought of looking up John Sturrock's web listings for what is on in Scotland, but couldn't remember the URL. Never mind just go to the Society website and look up "Events". After all there is a special heading for events. Wrong, you won't find any listings there. They are hidden away at the bottom of the Help menu where surprisingly there is no "help" [FAQ is still blank] just "History" and "Technique Panel" items. "History" and "Technique Panel" are items which should really be under "Learn", since that is the most suitable tab they have and EVENTS should be under EVENTS. Can this be fixed please?

Let me just finish by saying some of these matters have been brought up on the Strathspey Server forum. To date there has been no Management Committee comment. Is this not a bit surprising? Might they not have responded, even just to explain their position? Well, that very point has also been raised recently on the Strathspey Server forum leading to the suspicion that Management Committee Members are being "gagged" and prohibited by the "Society Official Secrets Act" from communicating with ordinary members. Now that couldn't possibly be the case – or could it???
