Postage Stamp Increase—4th April 2022

1st class stamps are going up by 10p and 2nd class by 2p on 4th April 2022 making First Class 95p and second class 68p Large letter stamps will also increase, 1st class by 16p to £1.45 and 2nd class by 9p to £1.05. Remember if the weight of your letter is over the basic 100 gram limit you need to add extra postage to these prices.

If you or your Branch/Club purchase stamps in advance of such a price increase, to save some money, you need to use them up before 31st January 2023 or swap them for the new Barcode ones before then. (see below)

New **Barcoded** stamps are now being rolled out. This means stamps without barcodes can no longer be used after 31st January **2023.** Royal Mail will operate a 'swap out scheme' after 31st March 2022 to swap existing stamps with the new barcoded ones. This will be a free service. Full details of how it will work are not yet available.

After Covid News Report

You will notice this Newsletter is quite thin on dance details and that may be as a result of the hangover from two years of Covid restrictions. These are the only programmes I could source online and even the Society website has no current news according to the links on the **Blog page**. Looking at the <u>Society website</u> News & Blog Page I see the RSCDS news page latest link was to signal the lifting of Scottish public health enhanced measures on 24th January; the link to the **events page** latest article is dated October 2020; **Management Board Meeting Highlights** end on November 2021 and there have been no **Branch Mailings** at all in 2022. The only communication appears to be a monthly email called *Dance Scottish Together*.

However there are links on the **website Home page** and also the *Dance Scottish Together* email to **future Events** which are not referenced on the **Blog page**. It would be helpful if these links were all updated. Dancers following the out-of-date links will think there is nothing happening!

Following the lifting of Covid restrictions not all dance groups have restarted and this may be as a result of dancers being unsure if it is safe for us to mix socially. This has been reflected at most dance events to date where the numbers attending are down on pre-Covid numbers. I'm afraid we will just have to accept that Covid is here to stay just like flu, and flu didn't stop us dancing. Just remember what you are missing out on by not resuming dancing.
